Vacation Week is a card drafting game for 2 to 4 players about going on a one-week vacation and stressing about getting the most out of it.

Supplies needed:

- A4 sized sheets, preferably thicker than average printing paper. If you are unable to print or get such paper, I recommend cutting out additional sheets or spare playing cards as back cards, for added thickness.
- 64 solid color back card sleeves (Magic card size, to fit 63x88mm)
- 8 transparent/clear card sleeves (Magic card size, to fit 63x88mm)

Instructions (cards)

1. Print all pages in the file VacationWeek_AllCards.pdf with single-paper settings and cut them out into individual cards.
2. Put the Experience cards into the solid colored card sleeves, and the front and backside of the Event and Weekend cards, and the Direction card in the transparent/clear card sleeves.

Instructions (VacationWeek_Rulebooklet.pdf)

To print this file, you'll need a duplex-printer (can print double-sided), or you'll need to print half the pages first, flip them (flip them from bottom to top), put them back in the printer and print the other half.

NOTE! When printing on a duplex-printer, mark it as "flip along the short side", otherwise half your rulebook will be upside down.

Cut according to the lines on the corners and then fold the sheets into a booklet. If you are able you can staple or do some bookbinding between the sheets. You should now have an A6-sized rulebook.
